Lent 2024: "A Living Echo: Listening Through Lent"

"Catechesis" is the term the early church used to describe the purpose of its three-year process for preparing people for baptism, which often culminated in an intensive final stretch in the third year during **Lent**. For many Christians today, however, the word *catechesis* has become more commonly associated with the word *catechism* - commonly a summary principles/doctrine in the form of questions and answers, used for the instruction of Christians. This is not what the word *catechesis* actually means, though, nor is it what the early church meant by it.

Catechesis (κατηχέω) comes from two other Greek words, "kata" and "akouw," which together literally mean something like "to listen alongside." We get our word "echo" from this word, and that's exactly the sense behind its early Christian usage! Catechesis is the process by which we, the Church, come "alongside" one another to help each other learn how our lives can be a "living echo" of Jesus. Catechesis, and these forty days of Lent, in particular, are about helping us learn how to live the way of Jesus.

This year in worship throughout Lent at GLC, we'll be placing an intentional emphasis on *listening* throughout Lent. We'll engage in several different opportunities to truly pause and *listen* for how God is speaking to us through scripture, through music, through relationships, and so much more.

We hope you will join us at Gethsemane this Lent as we listen alongside one another and living our lives as an echo of Jesus!
